Training is restricted to a maximum of 30 delegates for 2-day Foundation courses or 40 delegates for Annual immunisation updates in any single session.

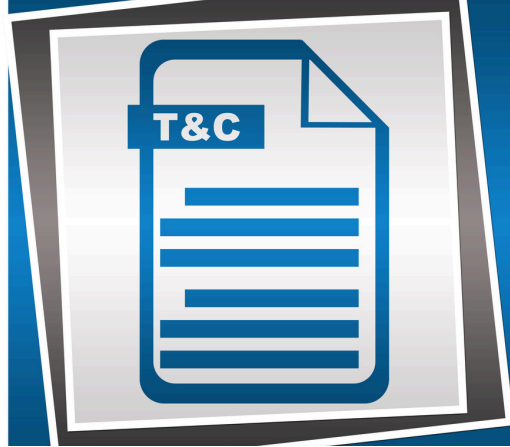
Introduction to Travel Health (2-day) course has a maximum number of 20 delegates.

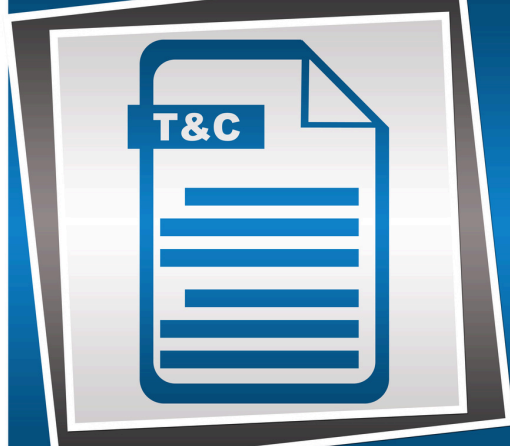
